Some Driving Facts

9% of all drivers 15—19 yrs. involved in fatal crashes were reported as distracted at the time of the crash. This age group has the largest proportion of drivers who were distracted at the time of the crashes.

According to a 2016 State Farm survey, teens who reported using their smart phone while driving were much more likely to report being involved in a crash while driving and exhibiting other dangerous driving behaviors including speed, failing to wear seatbelts, and driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs. Distracted driving is any activity that diverts a person's attention away from the primary task of driving. **All** distractions endanger driver, passenger, and bystander safety.

According to a study by the Virginia Tech Transportation Institute (VTTI), **sending or receiving a text takes a driver's eyes off the road for an average of 4.6 seconds; the equivalent of driving blind at 55 mph for the length of entire football field.**

The Ad Council and National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) launched a cam-

campaign in 2012 to raise awareness of this dangerous behavior.

The campaign shows drivers that no matter how "safely" they think they can engage in distracted driving, the behavior is always dangerous—for every driver, all the time.

Here are a few apps that address the issue:

Drive Safely—reads your text messages and emails to you while you are behind the wheel.

AT&T's *Drive Mode* app can send an auto response to any text received while driving.

Textecution—offers parental controls that can disable texting while driving.

There isn't anyone who gets behind the wheel that doesn't believe they are a good driver. That they do not have any bad habits like using knees to steer, eating or drinking sodas or hot coffee, putting on make-up, checking their phone, or some other distraction. I admit to one or more at one time or other, how about you or your kids if applicable?
