Election will be held at the Jan. 17, 2018 Neighborhood Meeting.





## Shady Banks – Let's Organize Our Preparedness for the Next Storm Together

Fort Lauderdale has a Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) program that trains and certifies individuals to respond to emergency and non-emergency incidents as a volunteer extension of the Fire Department. These volunteers can be activated to provide first aide, fire suppression, light search and rescue and overall community damage assessment. I recently became a member of CERT and within weeks of my training Hurricane Irma came to town. After the storm passed I provided the local Fire Department with a Rapid Impact Assessment (RIA) of Shady Banks, letting them know which streets were impassable due to downed trees and location of visual damage to infrastructure, such as electrical lines.

To be better prepared for the next hurricane, I would like to have a better understanding of individuals in the neighborhood and their needs...who should be checked on first after a storm? Who is oxygen dependent and relies on electricity? Who is homebound and living alone? I would also like to learn about resources in the neighborhood such as who has generators, chain saws, ice making machines, and who might be available (after they have first secured their own property and safety of their family) to help with removal of trees blocking streets, getting water and ice to neighbors in need, and the like.

If you are interested in joining me in organizing this effort – both gathering of community information, as well as pre storm preparation and post storm assistance efforts, then please let me know.
