Thank you to the members of Shady Banks Civic Association, your membership dues make events like these possible.

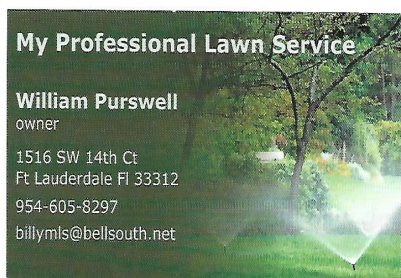

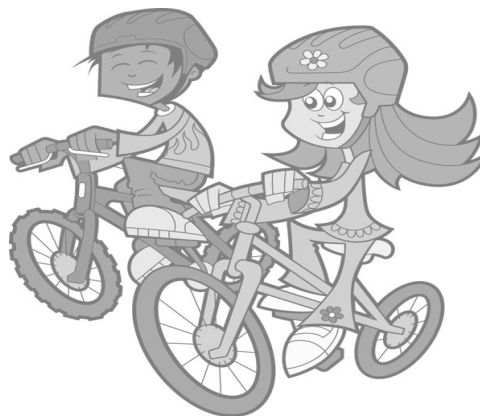
