City Code Compliance Department To Begin Aggressive Enforcement...

City Code Compliance Department will begin actively enforcing the ordinance pertaining to the timely removal of garbage and/or trash cans from curbside.

A warning will be issued for the "first" offence. Continued disregard will garner a \$150.00 fine per incident.

Basic Neighborhood Trash/Garbage Collection Info

- Household trash (black bin) is collected on Tuesday and Friday (twice a week).
- Recycling (blue bin) is collected on Friday (once per week).
- Yard waste (green bin) is collected on Friday (once per week).
- Need a new bin, log on to *lauderserv* or call 954-828-8000.

Curbside Set Out Information

Place your cart(s) roadside by 7 a.m. on pickup day, but no earlier than 6 p.m. the evening prior to your scheduled collection. *All carts must be removed from the road and secured on your property the same day after pickup service*. Containers shall not be left roadside overnight.

Bulk Trash

Provided by the City of Fort Lauderdale monthly. Shady Banks bulk trash pickup day is the first Wednesday of each month.
