ALERT TO SWIMMING POOL OWNERS!!!

Many of us here in Shady Banks have pools. We had a **VERY** scary experience with our chemicals today. I checked the chemical readings, and found that I needed to add stabilizer. I keep this chemical in tablet form in a plastic container, and put it in a floating container in the pool. I asked my housemate to add the tabs. When he opened the tub, gas **EXPLODED** out of it into his face. He was gasping for air, eyes, nose and throat burning, light-headed, foaming at the mouth, vomiting – terrible. I had to call 911, who responded quickly. Luckily, he is young and hearty, and the paramedics were able to restore him to normalcy without a trip to the hospital.

I am elderly. If it was I who opened the container, we would be having a different article. In fact, we probably would not be having an article at all.

I have been buying and using stabilizer tabs in this form for 30 years, so I was puzzled as to what happened. I called the pool store and was told that this is not a particularly unusual story. If water gets into the stabilizer tab container, a gas forms; so when the container is opened, the gas explodes. Of course we do not want to store these chemicals inside our houses; however, we need to be sure they are in a place where they stay dry. Additionally, when you open one of these containers, keep it at arms-length and stand back, with the awareness that it may emit dangerous gas.
